




GreenCo Awareness Programs


Some create trends and some understand trends; GreenCo, creates and understand trends. GreenCo trends have the staying power and has been changing the outlook on environment sustainability for industries.


A Long Term Value addition

The response from the respondents on GreenCo's value addition was unanimous: long-term. GreenCo identifies and strengthens several important aspects of sustainable business, that creates long-term value addition for an organization.



Contributor to the corporate green growth strategy

To deliver a strategic plan, is fundamental to the success and sustainability of any organization and is rightly applicable to its overall green growth strategy as well. GreenCo companies have indicated that GreenCo has evolved as an important contributor in devising the corporate green growth strategy. While a 24% response mentioned that it is important, 73% claimed that GreenCo is extremely important to the corporate green growth strategy.










The way of doing business

Recently, sustainable growth is used as a measure for gauging and understanding the progress of an organization and its business. The management's agenda

While the green agenda has existed for decades now, it was more of a regulatory and a cost perspective for the management. However, the trend seems to have been changing. Many industry leaders are rising to work towards sustainable growth. GreenCo, has made it to the management's agenda, certainly meaning going green has gained a lot of significance. GreenCo's experience, has mirrored the fact that, companies implementing GreenCo as brought out by the top management's agenda, have benefitted immensely.



Everyone's agenda too


The management's agenda would have failed if not for the involvement at the operations level. Successful GreenCo rated companies, did not just ensure GreenCo in the management's agenda but also in everyone else's agenda. On studying the responses, it has been noticed that different companies get different departments to lead the GreenCo implementation activity; however, they also ensure that the implementation is shouldered by everyone in the organization.







80% of the respondents considered "exploring new business opportunities in the environmental front" as the top-most highly-useful aspect of the GreenCo Rating System. Closely following this is a 78% response vouching for the fact that GreenCo "leads organizations to stay well ahead of competition". Not to forget the "Corporate reputation gain" through the GreenCo Rating System which settled in for the next highly useful aspect of the implementing GreenCo.



While the above-mentioned aspects were categorized under the highly-useful aspects, the following trends are categorized in the useful aspects.

75% of the respondents mentioned that GreenCo has been used as "a tool for marketing their products/processes as those from that of a green company", whereas the remaining 25% said GreenCo is highly-useful for this purpose. 50% of the respondents claimed that GreenCo is useful to "enhance the internal operations and utilize resources effectively", the other 50% claimed that GreenCo is highly-useful in this aspect.









GreenCo Rating System - Version 3

The GreenCo Rating System, has been developed to accommodate the entire spectrum of the Indian industry. The motive being greening the Indian industry, the rating system has been developed as inclusive as possible, encouraging every company to pursue green and become globally competitive. Considering the value addition the rating system offers, the GreenCo Rating System has been developed in such a way that it is neither-too-tough-nor-too-easy. On the other hand, to uphold the credibility of the rating, there has to be a continuous upgradation of the rating to ensure that the overall average goes up and companies will have to perform better to sustain the present level of rating and to move up the ladder. To fulfil this intent, Version 3 of the GreenCo Rating System was released in June 2018 posing more stringent requirements in all the parameters of the rating system.

Companies that have undergone the GreenCo Rating System have shown good performances and extended their initiatives beyond fences all leading to the path of excellence. We have more challenging tasks for the GreenCo companies in the years to come. 

'Availability of India specific inventory datasets a challenge'

The workshop was organised as part of the Sustainable Recycling Industries (SRI) project supported by the Swiss state secretariat of economic affairs and eco-invent.
